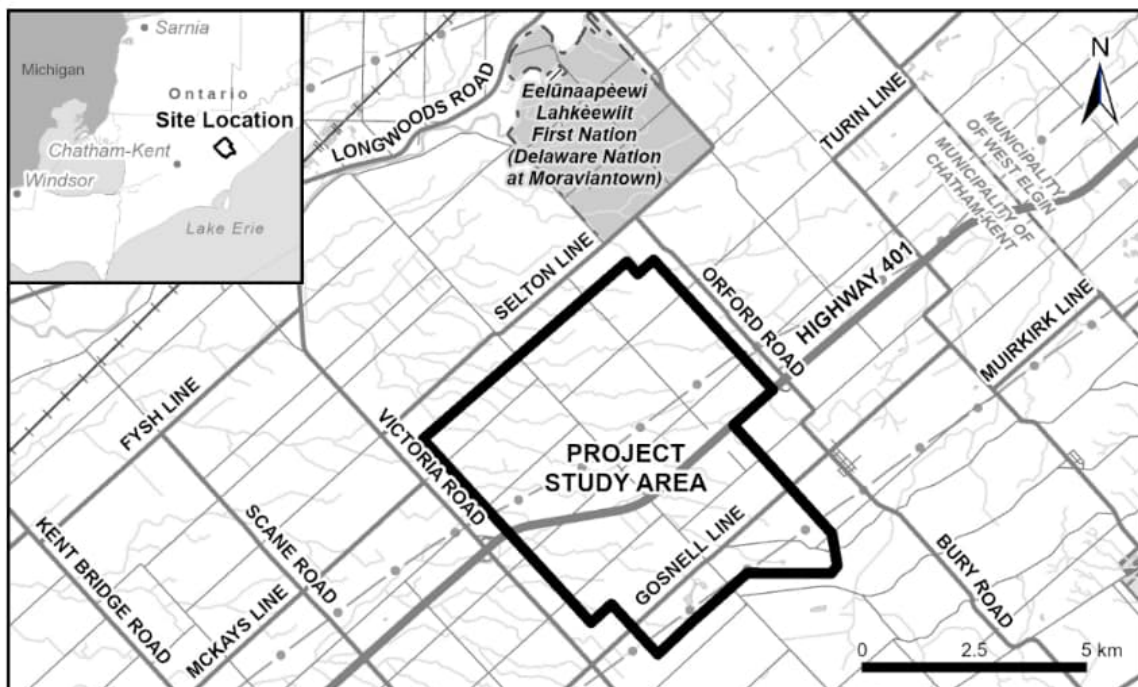


NOTICE OF COMMUNITY INFORMATION SESSION PROPOSED WIND FARM PROJECT IN CHATHAM-KENT

Ontario's electricity sector is seeing growing demand and the province, through the IESO, is planning to undertake large-scale resource acquisition to ensure sufficient supply will be available into the 2030s and beyond. Capstone Infrastructure Corporation (Capstone) is hosting a second information session in relation to our Crossfield Wind Farm project (the Project) proposed to be developed in the Municipality of Chatham-Kent. The Project is currently in the early development stage, and this additional community consultation is in advance of a contract with the IESO and seeking necessary municipal permits.

Capstone hosted the first Community Information Session for the Project on June 26, 2025. This second Information Session will address questions received as well as provide updates on the Project scope, including a preliminary turbine layout. The preliminary layout will be made available on the Project website prior to the event. The Project area has been reduced in size since the first session as shown below.

The Community Information Session will be hosted as an open house format over two 3-hour sessions with Capstone staff and subject matter experts available to address questions from attendees.
